The supplies in a Montessori classroom are shared with all the children. We encourage a sense of community by asking each family to make contributions. Classroom supplies (items in the first list) do not need to be individually labeled with the child's name. If you are unable to fill this supply list, we understand.

Every child should bring a full-size backpack to school each day. This will allow us to send school notes home and to help your child become more organized. **Please label your child's book bag with their name and room number.**

Suggested Classroom Donation of \$20.

This money is used for maintaining classroom animals, cooking supplies, art projects, classroom subscriptions, and/or special history or science projects.

- Erasers (not pencil top erasers)
- Dry Erase Markers
- Graph Paper (1 package)
- Lined paper (1 package)
- White copy paper (2 reams)
- Tissue (4 boxes)
- Paper Towel (4 rolls)
- Colored Pencils (1 box)
- Disinfecting wipes (1 container-Seventh Generation preferred)
- Elmer's glue sticks
- Index Cards (1 pack)
- Method cleaner (1 bottle)
- Ruler
- Hand held pencil sharpeners
- Post-It Notes (one pack)
- Watercolors
