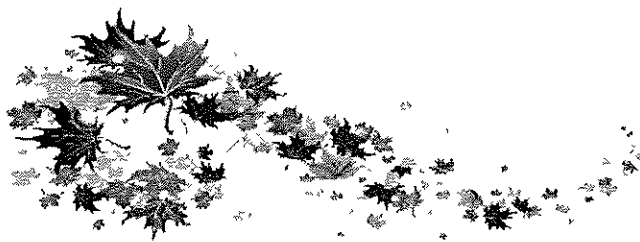

If your child needs shots you can take them to their doctor for the immunization. Otherwise, you can take your child to the Milwaukee Health Department for immunizations as well.

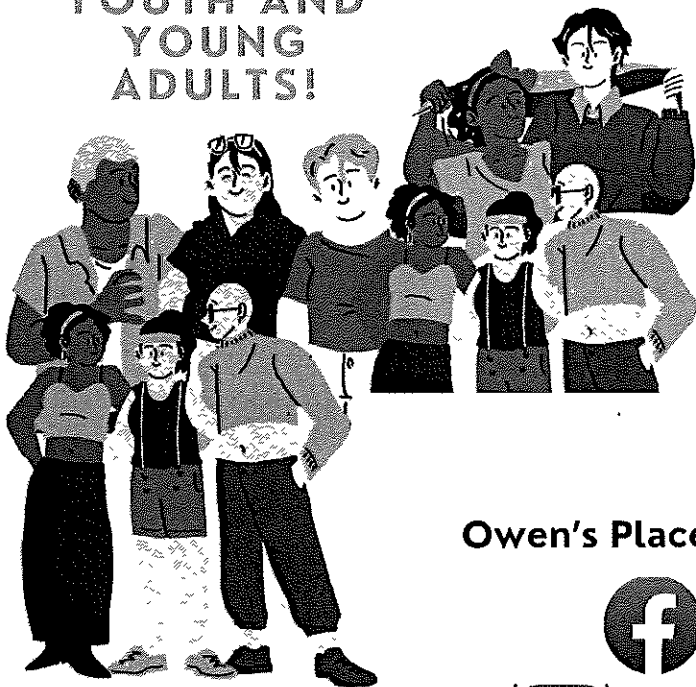

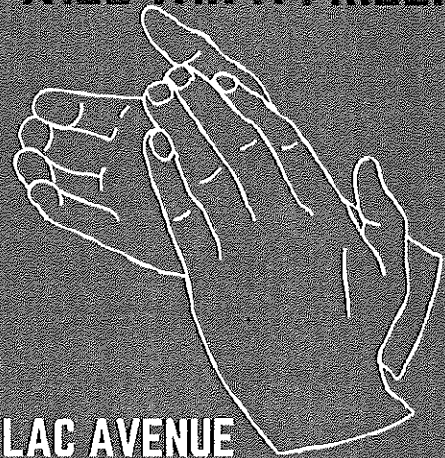
